we are glad to present to you the programme of the fourth LEOsings session in the beautiful city of Freiburg im Breisgau, Germany.

Find attached the current schedule, which – under the session title “Cooperation and Networks in European Vocal Music” – presents a wide range of topics regarding vocal music. Inspired by the great events in Barcelona, Aalborg and Tours we have filled three and a half days (yes, we had to start on Thursday morning to squeeze all the great content in!) with prominent speakers, great workshop coaches and experts from all over Europe. We want to make your stay in the Capital of the Black Forest a unique event full of what the title promises: Cooperation, communication and networking. And of course there will be a lot of making and listening to music too.

We are thrilled by the opportunity to experience one of the finest jazz and pop choirs in Europe, the Jazzchor Freiburg (cond. Bertrand Gröger) as the Saturday night concert at Theater Freiburg. As this is their album release concert and only hometown shown in Freiburg, we couldn't get the tickets for free, but you certainly won't regret this investment. And you don't want to miss the after show party in the theatre's brandnew and hip bar, Passage 46.

All the organizational details ought to be found in the registration form attached to this document/e-mail, but there's one thing that I want to highlight: We have a favorite hotel, the Novotel am Konzerthaus, which is a 4-star hotel with great breakfast and the only after-hour hotel bar in the city. It's also right opposite to the main station and the tram line you have to take to get to the conference venue. Unfortunately, we couldn't reserve rooms at a reasonable price, but there are rooms to be booked via internet that sell for less than 100 EUR.
